CURRICULUM TOPIC WEB FOR PARENTS AUTUMN 1

English

For the first half of the autumn term we will be completing descriptive writing tasks.

After enjoying the classic novel George's Marvellous Medicine, the children will be inventing and writing their own magical potions.

The children will then complete a persuasive writing unit of work in which they produce an information brochure to encourage people to stay at Spooky Towers Hotel.

Our non-fiction writing focus is going to be on dinosaurs! The children will carry out research before completing their own information books about their favourite dinosaurs.

PE and Music

We are lucky to be working with professionals in these areas throughout the autumn term.

We will enjoy basketball and gymnastic lessons from a sports coach in PE.

Mr Jones will begin to teach us how to play the P-Buzz in our music lessons.

SPAG

We will develop our skill of completing a variety of different sentences by exploring how to write and punctuate statement, question and exclamation sentences.

In phonics the children will revise and consolidate their knowledge of the sounds covered last year before moving onto starting to learn their Year 2 spelling rules in the 2nd half of the autumn term.

Maths

At the start of the academic year the children will secure their knowledge of place value.

They will also complete tasks, play games and learn songs to ensure that they know their number bonds to and within 10, 20 and 100 inside out.

Science

We will explore a story called Traction Man which is about a superhero that uses different materials to complete his missions. We will then explore what materials Traction Man would use to build the ultimate school and adventure playground.

Computing

We will spend the first half of the autumn term considering how we can use our computers and devices safely to help us with our learning and have fun.

RE

In Year 2 we concentrate on the religions of Christianity and Islam. This half term we will be exploring the question: Who is a Muslim and how do they live?

History

Our first topic in history is to learn about the Victorian Period. We will be finding out what life was like for children 120 years ago considering jobs, school, houses and toys.

We will also consider what impact the Industrial Revolution had on England and in the rest of the world.

PSHCE

Our first Jigsaw topic is called Being In My World. It will encourage us to set targets and understand expectations for the academic year ahead. We will also learn more about our brains during our Happy Mind sessions.
