CURRICULUM TOPIC WEB FOR PARENTS AUTUMN 1



English

In English, we complete a three-week writing cycle that incorporates everything your child will need in order to complete a 'Big Write' in the specific genre we learn that cycle. We will compose a fiction, non-fiction and a poem each term so your child has an opportunity to write a variety of text types. The genres we are focusing on this term is a setting description and an informal letter based of our class novel 'Goodnight Mr. Tom.'

Incorporated into the cycles will be a wide range of lessons to achieve to desired outcome. It will include: guided reading, analysing the features of the specific text type, Year 6 grammar that links to the text type, Alan Pete sentences, a shared write and independent write where they plan, edit and write up their final draft.

PE

During the term, we are very fortunate to be having professional coaches for our PE lesson which will be on a Tuesday and it will be football. We also have forest school every Monday afternoon this term.

French

Year 6 will be taught French by a subject specialist, Miss Binns.

Computing

In Computing this half-term, the children are learning about online safety.

Maths

In line with the National Curriculum, our Maths objectives are divided into ten areas. This term, we will be studying the following areas:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division

We will develop both our mental and our written calculation strategies, and have the opportunity to apply our understanding through a range of reasoning/ problem-solving activities.

On top of our maths lessons we will be completing maths retrieval skills every day which taps in to previous learning whilst also involving new and current learning. We will also be doing arithmetic tests weekly.

RE

In Religion, the children will be reading the creation story and learning what this tells Christians about God. We will be then discussing the science of how earth began and understand how both scientist and Christians can share the same belief.

PSHE

Being Me in My World – Identifying our goals, being a global citizen and owning our Learning Charter.
Celebrating Difference - Explaining ways in which difference can be a source of conflict or a cause for celebration.

Science

As scientists, we will be: looking at how light travels, understanding how we can see objects and examining why shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them.

We will also be: making links between the components and cells used in a circuit, comparing and giving reasons for variations in how components function, and using recognised symbols when representing circuits.

History

In History, we will be focusing on war and its impact, particularly on Bury. We will be looking at the POW camps located in Bury and Walmsley Road. It will be an in-depth three-week block where the children have opportunities to explore their knowledge further.

Music

Year 6 will receive teaching from a visiting subject specialist from Bury Music Centre. The children will be learning to sing and use their bodies to create music!

Art/DT

We will be looking at the artist Henry Moore and trying to use his style of drawing to help us recreate his famous WW2 sketches.
