Wednesday 10th December – Christmas Dinner Day – Wear your Christmas jumper/outfit to school, suitable for the day, no football kits.

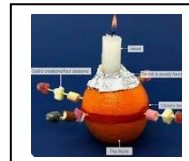
Wednesday 10th December – EYFS Nativity AM
