Year 1 had fun with Coach Owen learning about invasion games in PE.



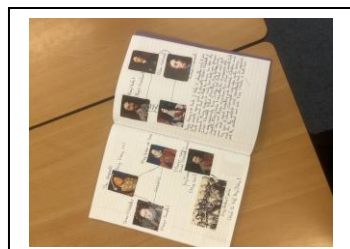
Year 5's Victorian Project pieces. Truly Fabulous!
