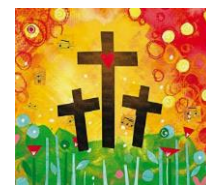

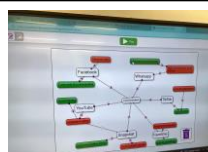
Wishing all our families a Happy Easter Break
