Our EYFS pupils have been making pizzas outside and selling them in their very own 'pizza parlour'.



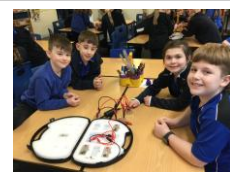
The caterpillar children are continuing to look at Antarctica and have been building 'icy' lands with the ice blocks. They have been looking at the different animals that live there.
