Please join with us, in congratulating Mrs Kelshaw as she takes on the permanent role of the school Business Manager this Spring term.



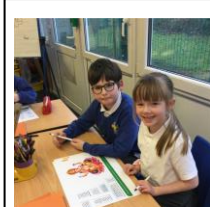
The children in Year 2 enjoyed their first ever judo lesson. They also loved watching the pantomime.

In their RE lessons, Year 4 have been learning about the Hindu God Ganesh.



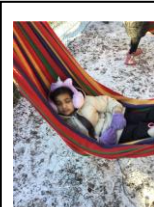
Year 1 had an amazing time at their wintry Forest School session, led by Mr King.
